### **Transforming Lives with ArtsCare**

In 2021, an ArtsCare workshop brought together 15 newcomer women, shy and reluctant to engage, after 5 weeks of assorted arts classes from dance to sculpture, they were laughing, sharing stories about what they did in speeches to their Mayor and local VIPs.

Loneliness shortens lives and ArtsCare combats this illness by bringing music and art classes to residents of subsidized long term care homes, boosting spirits and resilience with sparkling live entertainment, giving them something special to look forward to.

Worldwide research shows creative therapies are effective, low-cost, non-pharmacological

treatments that prevent illness, increase wellness, and reduce healthcare costs. This is **ArtsCare:** a program to bring mental wellness to vulnerable groups by providing joy through accessible creative experiences.

ArtsCare builds confidence, nourishes the soul, and supports artists with meaningful professional work. MAC is a national leader in ArtsCare, piloting a social prescription program to integrate ArtsCare with arts and social service agencies.

MAC's MicroGrant program provides seed funding to artist-led projects that benefit artists and residents.

MAC has supported 182 projects since 2019, providing \$460,750 in funding to local artists. But only 1 in 5 qualified projects can be funded.
